Composer

Writes the music.

Librettist

Writes the story.

Lyricist

Writes the song lyrics.

Director

In charge of the dramatic performance.

Musical
Director

In charge of the musical performance.

Choreographer

Creates the dance moves.

Designer

Designs the sets or costumes.

Performers

Play the characters in the musical.

Character
song

Describes how the character is feeling.

Action song

Describes what is happening at that point in the story.

Transition

A passage of music composed to link one piece of music to another.

Score

Written notation to show what notes to play and in what style to play them.

Script

Written text of a play or musical.
